Position Description:

The PA announcer will run music, read announcements, and help with the flow of our show script. The PA announcer will also be asked to help with setup and clean up of PA equipment each game. This is not your typical baseball announcer position, you are here to help run the non-stop entertainment that we are providing our fans.

- Run music via Sports Sounds Pro on team provided laptop
- Keep fans entertained with sound effects & music throughout the show
- Help run between inning promotions with music and audio
- Make announcements via our show script
- Keep track of substitutions throughout the game
- Help with setup and breakdown of PA equipment
